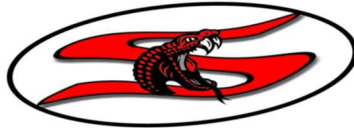

Parking: Parking is limited (first come, first serve basis)

Tickets: Tickets are \$50 per person or \$80 if bought as a couple. Each student needs to be present and have their SCHOOL I.D. to purchase a ticket, even if someone else is paying for their ticket.

Tickets will go on sale on Monday, April 8, 2024, in rooms 413 and 433.
MySchoolBucks is the only* form of payment accepted.

- From April 8th to April 19th, Seniors will be able to purchase tickets.
- From April 22nd to May 3rd, Juniors will be able to purchase their tickets.

Tickets are associated with specific students and are not to be resold. Tickets will be checked at the door and cross-referenced with names of original purchase. Any student who is not on the list, will be denied entrance.

Any guest who is an underclassman or not from Sharyland High School needs to pay for a Prom ticket through the Junior or Senior student from Sharyland High School who is accompanying them.

All prom ticket purchases are non-refundable. Any student or parent that purchases a Prom ticket is forfeiting all monies and will not receive a refund.

Menu Items: Dining is buffet-style. There are no assigned tables. There will be buffet and snack carts available.

Dress Code: Dress code rules are in effect any time a student is on school property or at a school-related function. There are times when the school administration allows exceptions to this policy.

At semi-formal and formal events, gentlemen are required to wear jackets. Ladies are allowed to wear evening attire. **Denim wear will not be permitted.**

Reminder: The following are some areas concern on dresses and are not allowed:

- Dresses showing midriff (exposed stomach)
- Dresses having slits three inches above the knee
- Dresses having bare backs below the waist line
- Dresses shorter than three inches above the knee
- Dresses having a plunging neckline or over exposure.

Conduct: Please refer to the Student/Parent Handbook and Student Code of Conduct for additional dress code guidelines at www.sharylandisd.org. **Students who are in violation of dress code will be asked to leave the event.**

The rules of good conduct and dress code will be observed at all social events, assemblies, banquets, etc., held outside the regular school day. **Guests are expected to observe the same rules as Sharyland High School students attending the event, and the student who invited the guests will share responsibility for the guest's conduct.** A student attending a party or social event may be asked to sign out when leaving before the end of the event; anyone leaving before the official end of the event, will not be readmitted (Student/Parent Handbook).

- Students must bring their ID card and Prom ticket the night of the event.
- Smoking or drinking is not permitted.
- **As an off-campus event, students will *not* be permitted to go back to their vehicles once they have entered the event.**
- **Once students leave the ballroom, they will not be permitted to return.**
- **Banquet Hall will close at 12:00 AM; all guests are required to leave at that time.**

Follow the rules. Administration has the discretion to determine if attire is appropriate.
